

Pre-Operative Clinic (Arthroscopy)

I'm one of the specialist pre-op nurses. Pre-assessment is about making sure that you are safely prepared for your surgery. If you come in for arthroscopy you will have either a clinical appointment or a telephone assessment.

At clinic, you will see a member of the nursing team who will check your height, weight, temperature, pulse, blood pressure and take an ECG and some MRSA swabs.

If you need a telephone assessment, we will also go through your health history with you and give you information about what will happen when you come in for your surgery. We will also give you an additional appointment to have some MRSA swabs taken.
